WORKS TO TREES

Burton & Winkton Parish Council is keen to safeguard the rural character of the villages of Burton, Winkton, Bockhampton and Holfleet. Applications involving a diseased tree should be accompanied by an arboricultural report. This parish council takes the position all healthy trees and especially the mature and vintage oak trees must be protected. The felling of any tree has a detrimental impact visually to the parish landscape and to the wellbeing of the majority of villagers so should be discouraged. Any tree that could be saved, should be saved. Felled trees, whether supported by an arborist's report or not, should be replaced 'Fell One, Plant One'.

This parish council is supportive of necessary tree maintenance such as the removal of dead limbs, the thinning of canopy and/or reduction of crown of a healthy tree.
